The GrandBear Group is more than a name; it symbolizes our collective commitment to fostering change and creating a brighter future for future generations. With your involvement, we are confident that we can reach this year's initiative's financial goals and make a profound difference in the lives of our BCS Bears.

This year's wonderful initiative focuses on updating the playgrounds on campus to create a safer and more enjoyable space for the kids. The project cost is \$81,000 and includes:

- Removing current obstacles to maximize play space.
- Remove all pea gravel.
- Fresh EWF mulch will be added to all on-campus playgrounds.
- Installing new wrought iron fencing with new gates.

We will break this into two phases to help achieve our completion goals. Phase one's goal of \$56,000 will allow the removal of obstacles, pea gravel, and new EWF mulch. Phase two's goal of an additional \$25,000 will enable us to update the chain link fence to a 4' tall wrought iron fence with gates.
